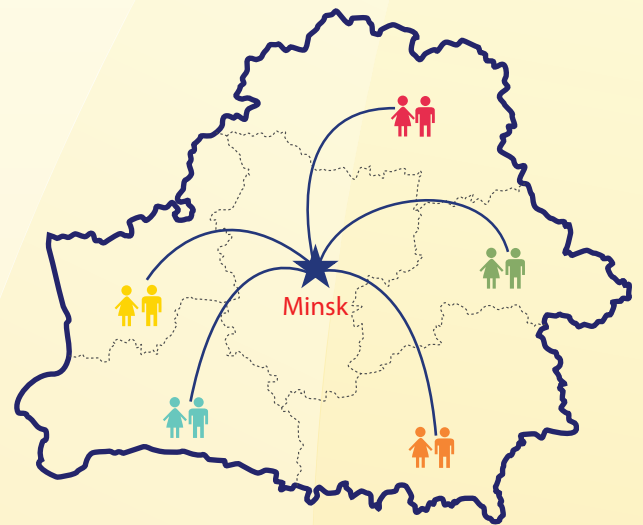


THE CLEARING HOUSE
